Despite the decent remuneration and the significant authority, prestige, and influence that come with the roles, there's a noticeable decline in individuals vying for positions in this year's local government elections in Queensland. Statistics from the Electoral Commission of Queensland indicate a 10% reduction in candidate numbers since 2020, leading to a 33% increase in the number of mayors and council members who will assume their roles unopposed on March 16. With 61 positions being secured without competition, it raises the question: Is this indicative of a disinterest in local governance or contentment with the current leadership?

Paul Williams, a political scientist from Griffith University, offers insights into the "candidate scarcity." Dr. Williams suggests that the prevailing economic challenges and the escalating cost of living have led voters to focus more on personal financial stability, overshadowing other concerns. "People are prioritising their immediate needs, like affording groceries and housing expenses, over community involvement," he explains. "This shift has diminished their capacity to engage with broader community-enhancing initiatives."

Sentiment in the Scenic Rim, although sympathetic to the challenges and disruptions posed by a handful of recent natural disasters, is that the current Council structure and operation is toxic beyond repair, and it really is time for a clean sweep and fresh start.



# BREACH OF CODE: RULING ON MAYOR CHRISTENSEN RAISES MORE VOTER CONCERNS ON ELECTION EVE

Mayor Greg Christensen of Scenic Rim Regional Council was found to have breached the Councillor Code of Conduct by using his personal email for official council business. In a council meeting marked by extensive debate, a majority of councillors resolved that Christensen should pay \$5,000 of the \$25,143 investigative costs and publicly acknowledge his violation in the upcoming March council session.

Additionally, Christensen is to bear his legal costs, with a warning that any future infractions will be classified as misconduct. The breach traces back to an email Christensen sent to then Minister Steven Miles, seeking to overturn a council decision about his conduct, using his personal email, which prompted a complaint from the Local Government Department's Director General to the OIA, as Christensen revealed during a council inquiry.

Cr Jeff McConnell recused himself from the discussion to avoid a conflict of interest, as did Christensen, given his direct involvement. Before exiting, Christensen faced council queries, admitting his judgment error and attributing it to stress and a supposedly defamatory campaign against him.

Post their departure, the council examined the investigation report, which confirmed Christensen's admission of the breach, citing emotional distress and pledging to prevent future lapses. The council, with Cr Marshall Chalk presiding over the debate, affirmed the breach and dismissed Cr Michael Enright's motion to absolve Christensen.

Cr Virginia West highlighted the code's directive against personal email use for council matters, supported by advice from the State Government Advisor. Despite Enright's motion to waive penalties, the council determined Christensen must make a public admission and debated his financial contribution towards the investigative costs, ultimately deciding on \$5,000 after amendments to Cr West's initial motion. Christensen is also tasked with his legal fee repayment, adhering to the council's policy on legal expense coverage in defence against OIA complaints, dependent on the complaint's verdict.

#### PAPER WASP NEST

Ropalidia plebiana, cactus, Eagle Heights.



The beautifully made nest is located on a cereus cactus over three metres high, by the side of the road. The species is unique, being the only temperate wasp in the otherwise tropical genus. It is mainly found in New South Wales, where aggregations of nests are known to occur, and in The Australian Capital Territory. It is also found in tropical Queensland as well as hereabouts. An egg can be seen in the bottom left cell. The wasps make their nests by mixing saliva with weathered wood. This is one of three species of paper wasp I have filmed.

### **McConnell reaction to** ALLEGED SMEAR CAMPAIGN

Scenic Rim Mayoral candidate, Cr Jeff McConnell, said he was disgusted by an anonymous smear campaign suggesting he did not support tourism or Destination Scenic Rim.

Destination Scenic Rim (DSR) is a collection of local businesses, including farmers, winemakers, chefs, B and B owners and sustainable tourism.

"I have been contacted by several DSR members over the last few days advising me that they are aware of rumours circulating in the Scenic Rim that I do not support tourism or the DSR," he said at the weekend.

"This is a total and utterly dishonest fabrication which could not be further from the truth.

"These rumours are clearly designed to affect voting in the Scenic Rim Council elections."

Cr McConnell said that as the Portfolio Councillor for Tourism and Regional Events he had actually been heavily involved in promoting both tourism and DSR.

"I have worked hard supporting businesses that have been struggling under council red tape and helping with the resolution of these issues. I have constantly promoted the expansion of sustainable and responsible tourism within the Scenic Rim and have assisted new businesses in getting started.

"With respect to DSR, I was a champion for the one LTO-DSR and worked hard assisting with combining the three LTOs in 2020-2021.

Cr McConnell said that at a recent meeting with DSR members he had affirmed that if elected Mayor he would seek to change the funding of DSR to performancebased, with an increase in funding as more members were admitted.

"I would like to see a better funded DSR that takes on a larger operational role in tourism and marketing," he said.

#### A TEST CASE WE CAN'T AFFORD TO LOSE

The outcome affects all Tamborine Mountain residents and all SRRC ratepayers.

Councillors recently unanimously refused a development application at 36 Young Street for 10 'nature-based' tourism cabins that would have resulted in a total of ~1000m² built form in ~ 0.5ha of a 4.36 ha site, within reduced setbacks to 11 rural residential properties. 5 of 6 buildings would have been partially or entirely within Council's highest risk landslide hazard zone.

Council's reasons for refusal:

- Do not approve proposals that could jeopardise the safety of people and property and create legacy issues for Council by allowing tourism development in or near high-risk zones.
- Preserve the amenity and privacy of residential areas while encouraging development on safe sites that do not impact neighbouring homes.
- Setbacks must be maintained for tourism development adjacent to residential areas.

The Developer has appealed. Considering the issues involved, a loss in the Planning and Environment Court would set disastrous precedents and pave the way to costly legacy issues for Council/ratepayers.

Council is the primary respondent in the Appeal. However, given the important principles in this case, residents who objected to the proposal will also represent our Community in court. This will cost an estimated \$150,000.

## **SOME NOTES ON THE SCENIC RIM ELECTIONS, MARCH 2024**

In the Scenic Rim council elections, we stand on the threshold of many paths. Some lead to more of the toxic and destructive policies of the last four administrations, the past two sinking to even greater depths.

Much damage has been done to Tamborine Mountain's environmental and semi-rural character in which most of its 8,000 plus residents have invested and which the approximately one and a half million visitors arrive each year to happily share.

Regarding mayoral candidates, **Mayor Christensen's** "one size fits all" view of the shire is the source of the continual substandard recommendations from Council's town planners, not stirred enough to wake up that there is a Local Government Act wherein residents are also key players. The amount unnecessarily spent on Appeal cases beggars belief.

Poor performance under Mayor Christensen's watch has been routinely reported in the Tamborine Mountain Progress's newsletters which are viewable on its website, www. tamborinemountainprogressassociation.com That the source of regular clashes between

Council and Tamborine Mountain residents is the town planning department has been lost on **Jeff McConnell**. Several residents have reported that when suggesting there is a problem with this department, Cr. McConnell has defended it. Whilst he promises to listen better, the many problems residents have cannot be resolved if the town planning department is saying the opposite.

Unless this is rectified, a "unified" Council cannot be achieved when a Division One Councillor's stance on behalf of mountain residents and supported by very strong planning grounds is regularly opposed by Council and the other Councillors. A recent unanimous Councillor vote supporting residents on the eve of an election doesn't rectify this.

Jeff voted to pursue costs against the Tamborine Mountain Progress Association and thus close the 108-year-old association on which Tamborine Mountain residents relied to front the many issues they have with Council.

TMPA supported Council for fifty three weeks before its about turn to support a development application which could never be built according to the proposed plans, and which Council in its original refusal

correctly stated it could never be conditioned. The effect on unfortunate neighbours has been devastating, not to mention the quiet area and the precedent for Tamborine Mountain itself. (The slippery slide towards a dog's breakfast.) Other plans Jeff proposes are admirable. He is roughly on the right track but has some way to go.

However, adopting military-style leadership principles due to his years in the military suggests an autocratic style not in accord with the principles of Local Government.

With his very strong background in the finance sector, **Tom Sharp** is our hope to tighten Council's spending and to stem the excessive leakage of ratepayer monies on e.g. outside consultants, unnecessary legal fees and exorbitant costs for services supplied.

Many Council problems urgently need to be resolved – lack of transparency, the toxic culture plus rate gouging are some issues Tom will be addressing whilst keeping an eye on sustaining the natural environment and conserving our natural resources.

Tom proposes to restore authority to the elected Councillors, returning local government to how it should work. Except for Division One representatives, Councillors in Scenic Rim currently function as extensions of Council bureaucracy.

Regarding Councillor candidates, **Amanda Hay** (Division One) has done an outstanding job for the past year, despite really strong pressure. She has stuck to her principles and delivered service to residents beyond the call of duty.

Her energy level is astounding, and her Councillor job has been strengthened by her long experience dealing with Council matters, issues affecting the whole shire and her detailed knowledge of the planning schemes through court appearances on behalf of residents and helping others with submissions.

And she supports a Council which values democratic principles rather than an autocracy.

**Kerri Cryer** (for Division 2) has long owned and published the community focused paper, The Tamborine Bulletin and is well acquainted with her mainly Tamborine Village community.

As her electorate would include the southern part of Tamborine Mountain, Kerri has been interested in the planning scheme, basically how it works and some explanation as to why the residents there so frequently clash with Council. I have been supplying her with some basic information with simplified explanations of how such a complicated instrument works (or doesn't work).

As for the Greens candidates in both Divisions One and Two, it should be noted that whilst the Greens are powerful in Federal and State government politics, as a political party they have no input into Local Government. Council works on an entirely different level and on different matters. Neither candidate has had any presence in the main local environmental organisations.



# THE LONG ROAD SPORTS CENTRE AND REGIONAL SPORT — WHERE DO YOU STAND?

The Tamborine Mountain Sports Association (TMSA) Board first presented the Scenic Rim Regional Council (SRRC) with a masterplan of the Long Road Sports Centre back in December 2017, as a road map for a seven-stage infrastructure development of the site in the lead up to the 2032 Olympic Games.

The SRRC Sports strategy 2010-2020 is to be shortly superseded by the 2024 – 2034 SRRC Sports Strategy. As it currently stands, objectives of the 2010 - 2020 strategy on Tamborine Mountain are yet to be realised - there is still no single sports clubroom or facility for any of the field playing sports clubs on the Mountain and the current sporting fields and infrastructure don't adequately support the amount of clubs and users we have.

Despite its own best efforts, the TMSA has been waiting for over 5 years for council to complete the updated sports and infrastructure strategy for the Scenic Rim region. This is an important document because it clearly defines the strategic intention of council leading up to the 2032 Olympic Games. To access the large State and Federal grants on offer in this period, it is important that the aims of our community and the council strategy are aligned, so that the TMSA can be successful in any grant submission.

A final draft of this 2024 sports strategy document was presented and endorsed by council last November 2023, but will not be released until next month in April 2024 (5 months after it was approved) and after the election, for "community consultation".

Over the years a variety of outside consultants have presented multiple drafts of sporting and infrastructure strategies to the council, but to date the TMSA and the Tamborine Mountain sporting community remain unclear of the intentions of council or the details of this current strategy, despite contributing a multitude of documents and submissions to assist.

The Long Road Sports Centre is run entirely by volunteers and receive no ongoing financial or other form of support from the council whatsoever. This is a highly unusual situation for a local government area. While it varies from area to area, typically, councils own the land on which sporting clubs are located. The Council normally leases the land to the club or association, while also contributing ongoing funds for maintenance and infrastructure development as part of a budget process. The TMSA has been successful in acquiring money through competitive grants for improvements of the site, but the ongoing maintenance, upgrades and repairs to the facility are not possible to fund through grants in most cases. These costs are made up from volunteer contributions, member fees, hire fees and event proceeds. As use of the site increases and

the facility continues to age, this is not sustainable.

Ahead of the upcoming election this weekend, to avoid further delays and to ensure transparency and accountability, the TMSA has invited incoming councillor and mayoral candidates to support the Tamborine Mountain and regional sporting and recreational community.

We want to know where they stand on this important issue, and for their position to be on the public record.

To that end, the TMSA Board presented all the Mayoral and Division 1 candidates with the following questions, and we thank those who have found the time to respond. Below is a summary of those responses.

For the full transcript of details, including the initial TMSA letter and candidate responses, budget submission and TMSA Master plan, use the QR Code at right.



- Will you continue to support the proposed masterplan that is currently endorsed by council, in its full form?
- Do you support an ongoing financial commitment for the TMSA to maintain and manage the Long Road Sports Centre precinct on behalf of the Council for the Tamborine Mountain and broader community? (The TMSA have requested a minimum contribution of \$250,000 per year to go towards maintenance, management, and capital reserves.)
- 3. Do you support the TMSA and the Long Road Sports Centre to be included in any ongoing strategic planning meetings that the Council or its officers may have regarding the lead up to and including the 2023 Brisbane Olympics?
- 4. Do you support a closer working relationship with the Council to assist with "in kind" donation of Council human resources for the identification and preparation of State and Federal grant applications in partnership with TMSA?
- 5. What is your wider commitment to the Long Road Sports Centre, the TMSA and sport in general on Tamborine Mountain?

#### **Mayoral Candidates' Responses:**

#### Jeff McConnell:

- 1. Yes, council has already moved this.
- 2. I will be waiting for Council strategy on Sports to give where we will go with funding and how this will look.
- 3. Of course, this has always been the case as we have discussed often. TMSA committee may not always get a seat at the table but definitely included.
- Marshall and I have discussed this, and it may be an initiative to fund a grants writer specifically for Community and sporting groups.
- 5. This needs to be part of our wider SR Sporting Strategy that looks at different Tiers as we have discussed.

#### Tom Sharp:

- 1. Yes. Community assets being managed by community need support, not control. It needs good management practice and restoring authority to the elected councillor.
- The model of expecting community groups to maintain council assets with limited resources is broken. Funding sources need to be dynamic and include multiple revenue streams. Community should have control and

direction, with government support. It is disgraceful that council voted on a draft strategy in November 2023 but won't release it prior to the election. This is zero transparency and accountability. Funds to support this initiative will come from a reduction of top-heavy administration in council.

- I fully support strategic planning. Council needs to listen to community and the specific needs of community across the region and develop sustainable strategies alongside these organisations.
- Yes. Council needs to review its own capabilities when it comes to delivery outcomes. If community organisations can provide more cost-effective outcomes, then funding should be delivered directly to them to avoid duplication of expenses and competing for grant money.
- The Long Road Centre is a multi-functional facility providing sports and recreation, leisure, disaster recovery, tourism, and sustainable projects for the community. Council needs to start listening, learning, supporting, and working with the community.

- Yes. If elected, I'm keen to understand how Tamborine Mountain fits into the draft strategy. I'm concerned that costs to run the facility are passed onto members, preventing people from participating in sport.
- Yes. I support the use of Long Road in the leadup to the Olympics and it makes sense for the TMSA to be involved in planning.
- Yes. It's remarkable that the Long Road Sports Centre can function as well as it does for events, users, and community groups with such a small group of volunteers.
- With background in local sport and having grown up here, I'm committed to helping the TMSA improve and develop the Long Road site to provide increased sporting opportunities for our youth and to benefit our whole community.

Steven Emerson - No response was received. (The Greens support the Long Road Sports plan) Amanda Hay - No response was received.

#### Greg Christensen -

In her short term since the by-election, Amanda Hay has been a breath of fresh air, demonstrating her skills in this regard under difficult circumstances.

Then something often not understood: elected Councillors are legally required to take into account the interests of all Shire residents, not giving undue weight to their supporters or to their Division. There are even formal aspects as in the Council's allocation of portfolios to each Councillor. For example, Amanda's is Parks, Gardens and Open Spaces. For those matters, she is responsible for being a knowledge-resource regarding the whole Shire for all Councillors.

This all adds to a mind-boggling workload if a Councillor takes their responsibilities seriously. Some onlookers seem to think that being a Councillor simply involves turning up to sit at an occasional meeting or attend an event. I have been a Councillor, and I can assure you this is not the case. Then, I was busy enough but, observing now, I realise it has become much more demanding, with commitments extending over most daylight hours and many evening hours, on and off the Mountain. It is certainly a not a part-time responsibility.

Division 1 is very fortunate to have the unusual candidate needed to fit such a challenging local template.


We wrote to the CEO, Mr. David Keenan this month asking for his help, we have had no reply despite the extenuating circumstances with the Natural Disaster.







# CULTIVATING YOUR INNER LIGHT

# WHAT ARE YOU AFRAID OF?

Research found that humans are born with only two fears: fear of loud noises and fear of falling. Other fears are learnt over time. We all need a healthy dose of fear to protect us from dangerous situations. However, some fears come in unhealthy doses which restrict a person's life. Fears of a particular object or situation have names such as: acrophobia (fear of heights); enochlophobia (fear of crowds); glossophobia (fear of public speaking); ophidiophobia (fear of snakes). Here's one we might all have a measure of since Christmas Day- lilapsophobia, fear of tornadoes. These fears typically germinate from a traumatic event.

I watched a video of one woman's journey to conquer her fear of birds. She had been attacked by birds as a young child. Her fear became problematic as a parent when she abandoned her three-year-old daughter on the beach because seagulls had gotten too close. She decided to engage in exposure therapy which began with a feather two metres from where she sat. Her fear was palpable- she cried, sweated profusely, and shook as she looked at the feather.

You may not relate to this poor woman's experience, but chances are you have deep held fears lurking inside that influence your behaviour and response to others. This is because none of us get through life unscathed. Some of life's tougher experiences leave us licking our wounds and implant in us a dose of fear that impacts future interactions and how we form relationships.

Fear of rejection is a big issue in relationships. It prevents us from taking the initiative in starting a relationship or taking steps to repair a rift. We become emotionally overprotective of ourselves because the sting of rejection is unbearable. Fear of rejection may also cause a person to prematurely give up on a relationship since doing this on their own terms seems a safer option than being rejected by their mate.

Fear of inadequacy also interferes with relationships. If we are fed a diet of shame in our early years, we may harbour feelings of never being good enough. This can result in keeping others at a distance. It can also lead to settling for a toxic relationship because you don't feel you deserve any better. Sometimes it drives people to constantly try to prove their worth in a quest to silence the inner monologue "you don't measure up".

Fear of uncertainty, fear of judgement, fear of closeness, fear of change... most fears come to light in the context of relationships. If you notice an unhealthy pattern in your relationships, begin by taking responsibility for your own feelings and behaviours. Pay attention to what triggers you into feeling or behaving the way you do. This process will help you to uncover fears that are operating under the surface. Fear is a bully that takes control. The more you avoid it, the more powerful it becomes. Diminish fear's power by taking a risk and doing life differently. The results will be worth it.

# LYMPHOEDEMA AWARENESS MONTH

March is Lymphoedema Awareness Month. I have spoken previously about the Lymphatic system and how important it is in our body, despite it being probably the most unknown system. It sits alongside our circulatory system and depending on how much we exercise, how much water we drink and how well we are, it may be a little sluggish from time to time. However, when there is a breakdown in the system the result can be pretty devastating.

What is Lymphoedema? To break the word down – "Lymph" and "oedema" is probably the simplest thing to do. Oedema just means swelling. So, Lymphoedema means swelling due to an issue with the Lymphatic system.

There are two main types of Lymphoedema – Primary and Secondary. Primary Lymphoedema generally appears for no apparent reason at birth, during puberty or at around the age of 30. This is usually due to a genetic or inherent issue in our system. Whereas Secondary Lymphoedema occurs as a result of damage to our lymphatic system at some point in our lives.

Every tissue in our body is made up of cells, the smallest unit of our body that can live on its own. For cells to survive they need blood which delivers the nutrients and oxygen we need. Once blood is delivered to our tissues via arteries or capillaries, the lymphatic system works hard to maintain just the right environment for us, filtrating

the blood 3 times per day. The majority of our blood is taken back to our heart by veins, but the level of fluid in the tissues is monitored by our

lymphatic vessels. When there is an issue with the lymphatic system as a whole, then the fluid builds up and cannot escape without a helping hand.

This whole process can be happening right under your nose without you even knowing, until you notice some swelling in your hand, foot, tummy etc. Initially there may just be a change in sensation - like a tightness, heaviness, pain or tension; or you may notice a watch, rings or your shoes feeling tighter. The earlier you act to reduce this swelling the better. When swelling gets stuck in a tissue and sits there for a little while, it can become fibrotic - or develop sticky fibres - that can make it a permanent fixture. The most common time we may develop Lymphoedema is following treatment for cancer or after sustaining a traumatic injury. At these times the lymph vessels or filtrating system can be damaged and not work as efficiently. Sometimes Lymphoedema can be reversible. However, unfortunately, many times it will be something that will need to be managed for life.

One of the most difficult parts of Lymphoedema I have witnessed in my clients, is that it represents an ongoing reminder of the event that brought it about initially. Or, there is a sheer frustration or disappointment that this is something they cannot get rid of not matter how hard they try to ignore it. This is so difficult to watch. I am thankful that there are things we can offer to identify and manage Lymphoedema, and although I cannot take away the problem entirely, to help people live a life that is still very much full.

# THE AUSTRALIAN KELPIE **DOG BREED**

A world-renowned herding dog, used mostly for work with sheep, kelpies are highly intelligent, hard-working and agile, having a natural instinct for herding. They thrive when given jobs to do, which makes them excellent in dog sports and agility.

One ancestor of the kelpie is the Scottish collie, imported into Australia in the late 1800's to help farmers manage their enormous sheep flocks in difficult weather and terrain. In Celtic "kelpie" is a dangerous shape-shifting water creature.

The original Australian dog was a female especially bred and her name was Kelpie, her puppies were impressive sheepherders, so the line of those dogs came to be called "kelpies." The actual mix of breeding was secretive until Bill Robertson undertook a lot of research backed with DNA testing in 2015. Ten years ago, the testing was expensive, but he was determined. The final analysis was that apart

from the Scottish sheep dog, there was between three to four percent dingo markers in the kelpie strain, and it was not just any dingo but from Fraser Island and mainland Australia.

The breed is not recognised in America by the American Kennel Club, where they are rarely kept as

to move efficiently in the same direction? Researchers fitted a GPS tracking device to a trained kelpie guiding 46 sheep in a 5-hectare field. They then built a computer model of what prompted the dog to move, crouch or drop. The dog binds the sheep together by weaving around behind and from side to side. Once this is achieved, it drives the group forward. If there are any gaps between the sheep, the dog attempts to bring them together. It is a

balance between being coercive but not threatening and moving forward. If a sheep doesn't trust a dog, it will face it, stomp the feet and maybe head-butt it, especially if there are young lambs.

The average lifespan of the kelpie is 10-15 years. They are a relatively healthy breed, however more are being recorded as having problems with their hips, elbows, heart and eyes. Hip and elbow x-ray is not mandatory for this breed but responsible and knowledgeable breeders are x-raying their breeding dogs. CA is a brain disease this breed can have, it is carried by a recessive gene, which means the parent may not have the disease, but a carrier, and two carriers must not be bred, a DNA test is available. Heart murmur, eye disease and skin allergy can also be a problem.






